Southland Maple Beech is a stunning interior solution for contemporary and traditional exposed ceiling finishes. It is well suited to both residential and commercial applications.

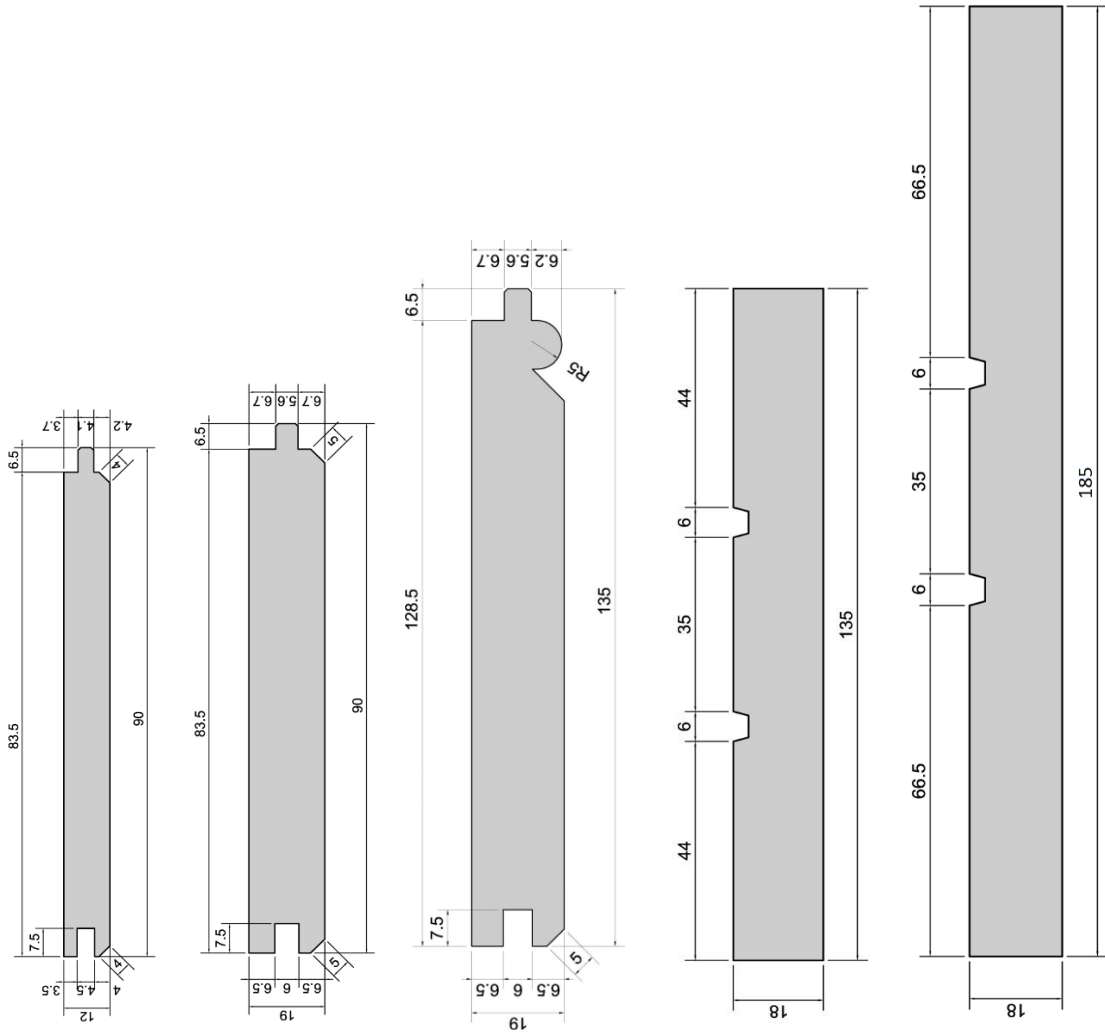

Installation can be by way of hidden fixings or face fixings. Various surface finishes are available including smooth, textured, micro-bevelled, wire brushed and sawn.

Southland Maple Beech ceiling lining is manufactured locally and is the only New Zealand native hardwood that holds the internationally recognised FSC certification.

The warmth and varied tones of the Southland Maple Beech, along with its thermal and acoustic properties, will add to the appeal of utilising this timber in a feature ceiling application for architects and interior designers.
